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Hello MCS Families,

We are reaching out today to provide you with information and expectations for remote learning during the hybrid learning schedule. Marion City Schools will be using the Acellus Learning System for students to use on the remote learning days.

As a reminder:

- Students in the "A" group for hybrid learning will attend school in person on Mondays and Tuesdays. They will log into Acellus each Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday for remote learning.
- Students in the "B" group for hybrid learning will attend school in person on Thursdays and Fridays. They will log into Acellus each Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday for remote learning.

### Expectations during Remote Learning Days

Students will be studying four subjects on Acellus: English Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies. You should expect them to work for up to **one hour per subject each day**. Occasionally, there may be other assignments from your child's teacher or from one of our Related Arts teachers or for social-emotional learning. All work, including the Acellus link, can be found in your child's Schoology program on their Chromebook. Your child can complete their work at the most convenient time of day for your family. However, a structured day, similar to being in school, is recommended. It would be best to keep as close to a regular school schedule as possible, which includes lunch and recess times. You are also encouraged to allow other learning breaks at different times throughout their day.

### Chromebooks

For in person learning, please be sure students are bringing their Chromebooks fully charged.

For remote learning, students will be practicing how to log into their Chromebook at school, but if you need assistance at home, please reach out to your child's teacher and they will provide you with technical support.

Soon, parents will be able to sign up for a monthly email that shows your child's progress. There is also an option for parents who want to see their child's progress more often. Details on how to access this information will be coming soon.

It's great to see our Prexies back in school! Whether it's in person or remote, we are committed and prepared to provide our Prexies with a quality education.
